

*Correctly caring for your piercing is extremely important. Please follow these instructions carefully to ensure that your piercing heals as best as possible.

Black Lace Ink Aftercare Instructions for Piercings

1. First and foremost, it is vital to **wash your hands** before handling or cleaning your new piercing.
2. If your jewelry has ball ends that can be screwed on and off, gently check them once a day or so to make sure the ball is on tightly to prevent them from falling off.
3. For the duration of your healing process, we recommend that you use antibacterial hand soap and warm water to wash your new piercing. Foaming hand soap by dial or soft-soap are the most recommended.
4. Mouthwash no more than once per day for oral piercings inside the mouth. Use warm water to rinse your mouth between mouthwash cleanings if need be.

Important side notes:

Do not use any alcohols or peroxides on your piercing, unless directed otherwise by your professional piercer.

It is essential to understand that your piercing can take anywhere from 6 weeks to over a year to fully heal, which often depends on the area pierced. Be patient and care for it properly.

Changing your jewelry too early can result in many issues like flare ups, jewelry rejection, irritation due to poor jewelry quality or metal allergy, infection due to unclean jewelry, and much more. Again, be patient and care for it properly. If you need help changing your piercing, please contact us. We can and will help you safely change your jewelry.

We do **NOT** recommend any sort of aftercare provided by other companies, such as ones from large retail stores, as these solutions often include many harsh chemicals that are not well-suited for the healing process.
